GOLFER EXPECTATIONS

PROHIBITED CONDUCT

- Zero Tolerance: The club has a zero-tolerance policy towards all forms of bullying, harassment, intimidation, and discrimination. Any behavior that undermines the dignity of others will not be tolerated and will result in disciplinary action.
- Alcohol Restrictions: No outside alcohol may be brought onto the premises in accordance with Alberta Gaming & Liquor Commission rules.

- Respect and Safety: No verbal or physical threats, slander, or disrespect towards others.

CLUB RULES AND REGULATIONS

TEE TIME MANAGEMENT

- Cancel tee times at least 24 hours in advance; failure to do so may result in a "no-show" penalty up to the full cost of a green fee per player.
- Check in at the Pro Shop at least 15 minutes before tee-off.
- Check in at the Pro Shop before playing an additional 9 holes.

COURSE CONDUCT

- Repair all divots, rake bunkers, and maintain course conditions.
- Keep golf carts at least 40 feet from tee boxes and greens (30 feet for those with accessibility flags).
- Operate personal golf carts safely; drivers must hold a valid driver's license.
- No more than four players per group unless authorized by management.
- No pets allowed on the golf course.
- Obey all course signage and follow Golf Canada and Golf Alberta rules.

CHILDREN/JUNIOR PLAYERS ON GOLF COURSE

- Accompaniment: Children 11 years of age or younger must always be accompanied by an adult on the main course with paid green fee(s).
- Independent Play: Children 12 years of age or older are permitted to golf without an adult on the main course as long as they can keep pace of play.
- Golf Cart Restrictions: Children/Junior Players under 16 years of age and without a valid driver's license are NOT permitted to drive golf carts on golf course property.

OTHER GOLF COURSE ETIQUETTE

- Estimated Play Time: Estimated time of play for 9 holes is about 2 hours.
- Course Marshal Authority: The Course Marshal has the authority to remove players from the course (without refund) if they fail to adhere to club rules and regulations.
- Pairing Up: If you are not a group of 4 golfers, you may be paired up with other golfers to speed up pace of play.
- Check-In: All players must be checked in and ready on tee box 1 at least 5 minutes before teeing off. Failure to do so may result in losing your tee off time.
- Equipment: All golfers must have their own set of clubs to keep up with pace of play.
- Divots and Bunkers: Repair ALL divots and rake bunkers.
- Safety: Golf etiquette dictates that golfers should always yell "fore" upon hitting a shot that carries the risk of hitting another golfer or damaging property. Golfers are liable for any damages or injuries that may occur.
- Cart Restrictions: No golf carts permitted on par 3 course (unless permitted by management; exceptions may be made if a player requires an accessibility flag).
- Pets: No pets allowed on golf course (unless otherwise permitted by management; exceptions may be made for service animals).
- Accessibility: If you require an accessibility flag, please ask Pro Shop staff to give you the
 "accessibility flag form" to fill out, then you can play with adjusted golf course rules to better suit your
 needs.
- Damage Reporting: Damage to the course and adjacent properties is the golfer's responsibility and must be reported to the Pro Shop promptly.

GOLF CART RULES

- Age and License: To rent or drive a golf cart on the course, a person (s) must be 16 years of age with a valid driver's license (not a learner's license).
- Riders: Only 2 riders per cart, even if the golf cart is designed to seat 4 people.
- **Distance:** All golf carts must remain a minimum of 40 feet from the greens and tee boxes, except for players with accessibility flags.

ALBERTA GAMING & LIQUOR COMMISSION RULES

• Liquor Restrictions: No outside liquor on golf course or pro shop property.

ALBERTA HEALTH & SAFETY RULES

- Smoking: No smoking on Patio.
- Pets: No pets allowed in Pro Shop or on Patio.
- Staff Areas: Only on-shift staff are permitted behind the Pro Shop counter.

DRESS CODE

- Acceptable Attire: Golf pants, golf shorts, or skorts; collared or mock-collared shirts; only golf shoes with soft spikes (no metal spikes) are permitted.
- Unacceptable Attire: Sweatpants, muscle or tank tops, spaghetti straps, inappropriate T-shirts (explicit language and/or content), ripped or torn clothing.

BOOKING A TEE TIME

- Booking Methods: Booking can be done online or by telephone (403.728.3010 ext 245).
- Advance Booking: Tee times will be available 7 days in advance for members and 5 days in advance for the public.

CANCELLATIONS AND NO-SHOWS

- Cancellation Policy: Cancellations and adjustments are permitted up to 24 hours prior to your scheduled tee time. No refunds will be provided for changes after this 24-hour period.
- No-Show Penalty: "No Shows" are extremely expensive for the Golf Club. If you cannot make your tee time
 or need to adjust the number of players in your group, please cancel or change it prior to 24 hours before
 the tee time. Failure to do so will result in players subject to a "No-Show" penalty up to the maximum cost
 of green fee per player.
- Member Infractions: In cases of more than one infraction of "No Showing," showing up with fewer players than booked, or making booking changes less than 24 hours before the tee time, a discussion with Resort Management will be held to discuss further actions.

RAINCHECK POLICY

- Inclement Weather: Gleniffer Lake Golf Course reserves the right to limit golf cart access to cart
 paths only during inclement weather. A raincheck may be issued for a future visit if staff deem the
 golf course unplayable.
- Raincheck Issuance: Rain checks will be issued based on the number of holes you completed before
 the course was deemed unplayable.

GOLFER EXPECTATIONS

PROHIBITED CONDUCT

- Zero Tolerance: The club has a zero-tolerance policy towards all forms of bullying, harassment, intimidation, and

CLUB RULES AND REGULATIONS

TEE TIME MANAGEMENT

- Cancel tee times at least 24 hours in advance; failure to do so may result in a "no-show" penalty up to the full cost of a green fee per player.
- Check in at the Pro Shop at least 15 minutes before tee-off.
- Check in at the Pro Shop before playing an additional 9 holes.

COURSE CONDUCT

- Repair all divots, rake bunkers, and maintain course conditions.
- Keep golf carts at least 40 feet from tee boxes and greens (30 feet for those with accessibility flags).
- Operate personal golf carts safely; drivers must hold a valid driver's license.
- No more than four players per group unless authorized by management.
- No pets allowed on the golf course.
- Obey all course signage and follow Golf Canada and Golf Alberta rules.

CHILDREN/JUNIOR PLAYERS ON GOLF COURSE

- Accompaniment: Children 11 years of age or younger must always be accompanied by an adult on the main course with paid green fee(s).
- Independent Play: Children 12 years of age or older are permitted to golf without an adult on the main course as long as they can keep pace of play.
- Golf Cart Restrictions: Children/Junior Players under 16 years of age and without a valid driver's license are NOT
 permitted to drive golf carts on golf course property.

OTHER GOLF COURSE ETIQUETTE

- Estimated Play Time: Estimated time of play for 9 holes is about 2 hours.
- Course Marshal Authority: The Course Marshal has the authority to remove players from the course (without refund) if they fail to adhere to club rules and regulations.
- Pairing Up: If you are not a group of 4 golfers, you may be paired up with other golfers to speed up pace of play.
- Check-In: All players must be checked in and ready on tee box 1 at least 5 minutes before teeing off. Failure to do so may result in losing your tee off time.
- Equipment: All golfers must have their own set of clubs to keep up with pace of play.
- Divots and Bunkers: Repair ALL divots and rake bunkers.
- Safety: Golf etiquette dictates that golfers should always yell "fore" upon hitting a shot that carries the risk of hitting another golfer or damaging property. Golfers are liable for any damages or injuries that may occur.
- Cart Restrictions: No golf carts permitted on par 3 course (unless permitted by management; exceptions may be made
 if a player requires an accessibility flag).
- Pets: No pets allowed on golf course (unless otherwise permitted by management; exceptions may be made for service animals).
- Accessibility: If you require an accessibility flag, please ask Pro Shop staff to give you the "accessibility flag form" to
 fill out, then you can play with adjusted golf course rules to better suit your needs.
- Damage Reporting: Damage to the course and adjacent properties is the golfer's responsibility and must be reported to the Pro Shop promptly.

GOLF CART RULES

- Age and License: To rent or drive a golf cart on the course, a person (s) must be 16 years of age with a valid driver's license (not a learner's license).
- Riders: Only 2 riders per cart, even if the golf cart is designed to seat 4 people.
- **Distance:** All golf carts must remain a minimum of 40 feet from the greens and tee boxes, except for players with accessibility flags.

ALBERTA GAMING & LIQUOR COMMISSION RULES

• Liquor Restrictions: No outside liquor on golf course or pro shop property.

ALBERTA HEALTH & SAFETY RULES

- Smoking: No smoking on Patio.
